


## Getting Started

### 1) Your NetVibes page


- Go to <http://netvibes.com> – you will see a default selection of ‘modules’.
- You can move these modules around, and add new ones from the menu on the left-hand side.

### 2) Create an account and make your own customized pages

- Click the  button, and then click ‘Register now’ from the options that appear on the left.
- Enter your e-mail address and password.
- Your NetVibes account is now set-up.

Add NetVibes to your bookmarks or favorites or return anytime by typing in the address <http://netvibes.com> and clicking ‘Sign In’ to access you own pages.

### 3) Add an RSS feed

- When you find a website with an RSS feed () find the RSS feed address (try clicking to view the feed and then copy of the address from the address bar)
- On your NetVibes page click  to open the left-hand menu and then click .
- Paste in the address of the RSS feed you found and click to add the feed to your page. Move it to where you want it.



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
